To sustain access for all 50,000+ students, we are institutionalizing our best practices and leveraging federal funds. Assessing Need for Every Student Every Year: We are incorporating the home digital needs assessment into the annual registration process Federal Funds for Home Access: We are utilizing the Emergency Connectivity Fund to continue providing computers and hotspots to all students. We are facilitating enrollment in the Affordable Connectivity Program (\$30/month) to subsidize long-term broadband to all eligible homes.
